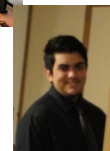
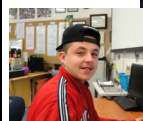
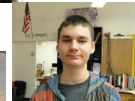
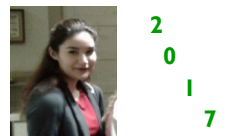
Caps and gowns have been ordered. **The cost is \$30.**
